You may fill your shoe box with a variety of gifts for either a boy or a girl ages 2-4, 5-9, or 10-
14. Listed below are some shoe box gift suggestions:

- "WOW" Item:** outfit, shoes, musical instrument, soccer ball with pump, stuffed animal, doll
- Toys:** small cars, jump ropes, yo-yo's, toys that light up (with extra batteries)
- School Supplies:** pens, pencils and sharpener, crayons, coloring books, writing pads
- Hygiene Items:** toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, washcloths
- Accessories:** socks, hats, sunglasses, hair clips, jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries)

Please do not include candy; toothpaste; used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy
guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; drink mixes; liquids or lotions; medications
or vitamins; or breakable items such as snow globes, glass containers, or aerosol cans.

You are encouraged to enclose a note to the child and photo of yourself or your family. You may
enclose a check for \$9.00 to help cover shipping costs. Checks should be made out to **Samari-
tan's Purse** and placed on top of gift items.

Please wrap the box and lid separately. Put a rubber band around your box and lid. Place a label
on the box lid stating "Boy" or "Girl" and the age group. Labels and more information about
